# **Our Faculty**

# **Our Curriculum**

Our curriculum is thoughtfully designed to deliver elite instruction to both recreational and preprofessional dancers. Rooted in **Classical Ballet** and **Lester Horton Technique**, our training approach integrates academic theory with practical skill development, ensuring each student receives a well-rounded, technically strong, and artistically rich dance education.

All dancers are required to maintain **concurrent enrollment in ballet**, which serves as the technical foundation for all other disciplines.

We offer two distinct training divisions to meet dancers at every level of experience and commitment:



### **Pre-Professional Division**

The **Pre-Professional Division** is designed for dedicated dancers ages **7–13** who exhibit advanced potential and a strong commitment to their craft. This program delivers focused, technique-driven instruction to prepare students for **conservatory-level training**, **professional careers**, and competitive performance opportunities.

The **Open Training Division** provides recreational and developmental training for dancers ages **2.5 and up**. This track is ideal for students seeking strong foundational technique, personal enrichment, or preparation for school dance teams and community performances.

All students are required to maintain concurrent enrollment in Ballet, with a minimum of one Ballet class per week.

# **Enrollment Instructions**

The TMJ School of Dance uses **DanceStudio-Pro (DSP)** to manage all student accounts, including registration, tuition payments, class schedules, and merchandise orders.

At TMJ, dance is more than movement—it's a transformative tool that builds confidence, discipline, creativity, and community. Our students benefit from rigorous technical training and a strong foundation in dance theory, preparing them for success on stage, in the classroom, and beyond.



### **Getting Started Is Easy**

If you're enrolling for the first time, just follow these four simple steps to create your account and register your dancer:

#### 1. Create Your Account

Click "Create an Account" on the DSP login page to set up your parent/adult profile.

#### 2. Add Your Dancer

Click "Add Student" or "I Am the Student" and complete the required information for your dancer.

### 3. Save & Log In

Once your account is created, log in to access the parent portal and explore available classes.

### 4. Enroll in Classes

Select your desired classes, then complete enrollment by paying the **registration fee** and **first month's tuition**.
